However, studies have shown that compressions are more likely to be inadequate when the patient is in this position; therefore, when compressions are being performed, manual left lateral displacement of the uterus, rather than left lateral decubitus positioning, is the optimal method. Interventions for both wide and narrow complex PEA should be followed by bedside echocardiography. This is a class I recommendation.
